This class is open to dancers with a minimum of two years of dance experience, with at least 1 year in a class **NOT** labeled as a beginner's class. In addition, these dancers have a good standard of footwork and technique, good phrasing and are very familiar with the common standard formations (including but, not limited to: reels of three and four, poussettes, allemandes, promenades, rights and lefts, chains and corner formations).
